# **Announcement / Invitation**

#### 1. General

The **Bavarian Open Competition** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the **Bavarian Open Competition** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 b) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

#### Feedback Sessions supported by ISU Development Program

As part of the ISU Development Program, Advanced Novice and Junior skaters from all disciplines and their coaches are invited to sign up for individual post-competition feedback sessions, including a video analysis conducted by ISU Officials. The host member (Deutsche Eislauf-Union e.V.) may exceed this limit. Members are welcome to add names of substitute skaters. Due to the total number of entries in each category, the OC will decide, if and how many substitute skaters/couples can be accepted. The OC reserves the right to limit the number of entries per category. If the OC has to limit the number of entries, priority will be given to those countries that have entered a Judge.
