- Participation: 1) The following ISU Members are eligible to participate: Belgium, Bulgaria, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Greece, Great Britain, Italy, Croatia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Norway, Austria, Poland, Rumania, Russia, Slovakian Republic, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Czech, Republic, Ukraine and Hungary with up to two participants in each category.
- 2) Teams from German state figure skating associations with up to two participants in each category. There is no limit to the number of German national team members who may be registered.
- The organizer withholds the right to register additional competitors. If the number of registrations exceeds capacity, the organizer may limit the number of competitors.
- Timetable: The timetable will be distributed in writing after registration is complete.
- Expenses: Competitors are responsible for their own expenses.

- Calculation: The ISU Judging System will be used to calculate the results.
- Judges: Participating clubs or associations are required to supply one judge per team with the minimum qualification "National championships" who is trained in the new ISU Judging System. If no judge is supplied, the registration fee per competitor will be doubled (90,- €). The organizer withholds the right to choose the panel of judges. Hotel costs for judges must be paid by the registering club or association.
- Registration: Your registration must include for each competitor last and first name, date of birth, club and country affiliation and competition category.
- Music: Separate CDs should be provided for each segment and labeled with name and category.
