Participation:

- 1. The organizer withholds the right to cancel categories or to limit the number of competitors, if the number of registrations exceeds capacity.
- 2. Registered athletes for assessment of approval for the national squad NK2 of the DEU in the category Advanced Novice and Junior have priority and should inform the organizer at the time of registration.
- 3. Registration must be made exclusively by the Regional Association (Landes-Eissport-Verband). Here the report must be made via the respective club (incl. Registration list). The registration of the participants of German clubs must be made on the provided DEU form, (see Appendix). Before registration, validation of the data via the DEU Data Assistant at http://deu-info.de/datenassistent/excel-validieren must be completed.
- 4. DEU License Fee (Lizenzgebühr): German skaters may only participate if the DEU license Fee has been paid prior to registration.

Individual Results:

The marking system (ISU Judging System) will be used in accordance with the respective ISU Communications. The three best-placed skaters in each category will be announced and honored at the official Victory Ceremony. By registering for the competition, the skater agrees resp. the legal representative of the skater agree to the publishing of the results on the internet.

Media/Internet:

Entry lists, results, photos, videos of athletes and livestream of the event will be published on the internet. With Competition Registration, the athlete or the athlete's legal representative agree to the publication of name, results, photos and videos.

Judges:

Participating clubs or associations are asked to supply one judge per team/ LEV with the minimum qualification "National championships". Hotel costs for judges must be paid by the registering club or association. The organizer withholds the right to choose the panel of judges.

The Heiko Fischer Trophy 2025 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024 and relevant ISU Communications. (Novice Categories will be held in accordance with ISU Communications 2624 and subsequent updates.) Starting in a lower category than the current season 2024-2025 is not allowed. According to ISU Rule 513, paragraph 2 the starting order for Junior and Advanced Novice Free Skating will be the reverse order of the result after Short Program. According to ISU Com. 2624 in all Novice categories warm-up groups will be up to 8 skaters. The warm-up time in all Novice categories will be according to ISU Com. 2624.

2. CATEGORIES SINGLES

JUNIOR Women and Men

Age requirements: In accordance with ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, Rule 108, paragraph 3

DEU PRE-ADVANCED NOVICE (U12) Girls & Boys

The age requirements are in accordance with DfBestDKBEK 04.06.2024: before the July 1st 2024 the skater has not reached the age of twelve (12)

For skaters starting for a German club, the **Kürklasse 4** is required according to the DfBestDKBEK 04.06.2024.

Free Skating only: Special attention should be paid to the contents of a well-balanced

program listed in ISU Communication No. 2624, paragraph 2.3.

Advanced Novice (including bonus system) and subsequent updates.

Duration: 3:00 min, +/- 10 sec for girls and boys

DEU NOVICE U10 Girls & Boys

The age requirements are in accordance with DfBestDKBEK 04.06.2024: before the July 1st 2024 the skater has not reached the age of ten (10)

For skaters starting for a German club, the **Kürklasse 6** is required according to the DfBestDKBEK 04.06.2024.

Free Skating: Special attention should be paid to the contents of a well-balanced

program listed in ISU Communication No. 2624, paragraph 2.2.

Intermediate Novice and subsequent updates.

Duration: 3:00 min, +/- 10 sec for girls and boys

DEU NOVICE U8 Girls & Boys

The age requirements are in accordance with DfBestDKBEK 04.06.2024: before the July 1st 2024 the skater has not reached the age of eight (8)

For skaters starting for a German club, the **Kürklasse 8** is required according to the DfBestDKBEK 04.06.2024.

Free Skating: Special attention should be paid to the contents of a well-balanced

program listed in ISU Communication No. 2624, paragraph 2.1.

Basic Novice and subsequent updates.
In both spins flying entry is not allowed.
